  - A maximum of six (6) credits of ART 2999 (Foreign Study) and/or ART 3999 (Foreign Study) may be used to fulfill the requirements of the Minor.
  - AP portfolio score of 5, AP Credit may be substituted for Art 1030 Drawing I, without further portfolio evaluation. No other AP Credit, nor Transfer Credit of any kind may be applied to the Minor.
  - I have read the above description of the Studio Art Minor. I am aware that my declaration of the Minor in Studio Art does not give me priority when registering for courses recommended for the minor.
